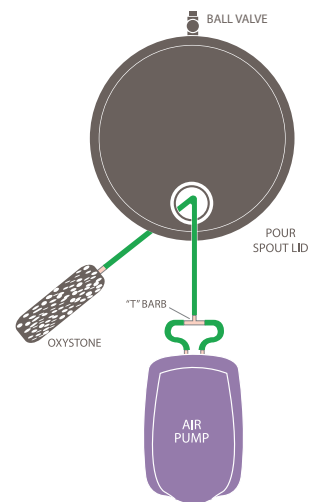


PARTS LIST

- A. 4oz Packet of Stump Tea
- B. Ball valve
- C. 5 Gal Bucket w/ Pour Spout Lid
- D. Dual Outlet Air Pump
- E. 48" of 1/4" air tubing
- F. 1/4" Barbed T Adapter
- G. Oxygen Stone

STUMP BREWER ASSEMBLY

- STEP 1:** Check to ensure that you have all parts listed.
- STEP 2:** Insert ball valve through grommet hole in bottom of bucket.
- STEP 3:** Close valve add 4 gallons of water to the 5-gallon bucket.
- STEP 4:** Add 4 tablespoons of Stump Tea and mix well
- STEP 5:** Cut (2) 3" sections of air tubing & attach to pump ports.
- STEP 6:** Attach open ends of 3" tubes to top of "T" connector.
- STEP 7:** Attach the remaining section of air tubing to the air stone.
- STEP 8:** Place the air stone in the bottom of the bucket.
- STEP 9:** Run tubing (from stone) through spout & connect to "T".
- STEP 10:** Brew (bubble) tea for 12 hours.
- STEP 11:** Stir tea thoroughly, and then apply to plants!



GROWING TIPS

- Fresh tea is the best tea. Use Stump Tea within 24 hrs.
- Compost tea should be used early in the plant's life cycle, although it can be used throughout the entire grow if desired.
- It is recommended to use Stump Tea once every 2 weeks. This will help to replenish the highly active population of biology.
- Stump Tea is full of natural ingredients that do not cause nutrient burn, so feel free to add a little extra or use it on top of your current feeding schedule.
- Between cycles, it is important to clean and sterilize gardening equipment. We recommend using hydrogen peroxide to clean your brewer.

3 EASY APPLICATIONS



FOLIAR

Mix 1 Tbsp. per gallon spray directly on leaves



TRANSPLANT

Sprinkle 1/4 to 1/2 Tsp directly on the roots



ROOT DRENCH

Mix 1 Tbsp. per gallon water roots normally
